

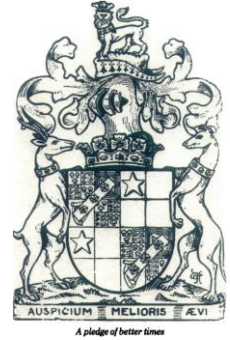
# Redbourne Parish Council Minutes

## 3. Chairman's Report

- Gardening – Best Community Planting 2016 & Silver Gilt in East Midlands In Bloom (RHS) small village category.
- Grant Funded – play area flooring, refurb of area and 2 new swings – Fire Engine restoration (see below).
- Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) – 30 questionnaires received back from residents, quotes in – grant applications to be investigated.
- Footpath – Vicarage Lane into play area, this is being funded 75% by the local authority and 25% by the Parish Council.
- New website in place to comply with the Transparency Act.
- Parish Council Vacancies – there are currently 2 vacancies, with an application for discussion at a subsequent meeting tonight.
- Defib + LIVES training – the defib has been located on the Fire Engine building and training has been provided by LIVES. Further training is to be provided later in the year.
- Village Signage – new signage has been erected at the east and west ends of the parish.
- Tree programmes – The Green and play area – this is being led by NLC.
- Increase in precept to allow Parish Council to improve the area as detailed above.

**Play area** – new flooring has been laid in the play area, the Clerk will now be investigating grant funders for the MUGA.
