Issues Raised by Residents

- i. Dog control in the village play area
A resident queried who has authority to enforce dog control within the village play area, following an incident in which a dog owner was asked to control their dog while it was running around inside the play area.

A concern was raised regarding an apparent increase in dog fouling along the village rights of way network. A member of the public reported that they have been picking up dog waste left by others and requested that the Council consider how best to address the issue.
